### Picture News

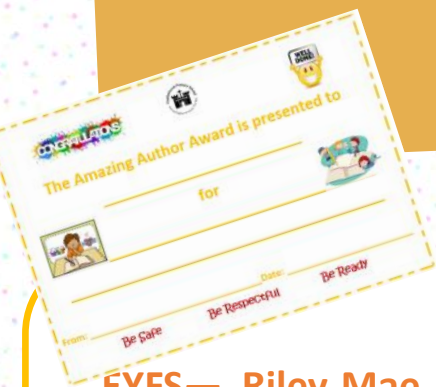
The UK government has launched a new website, prepare.campaign.gov.uk, designed to help people plan for

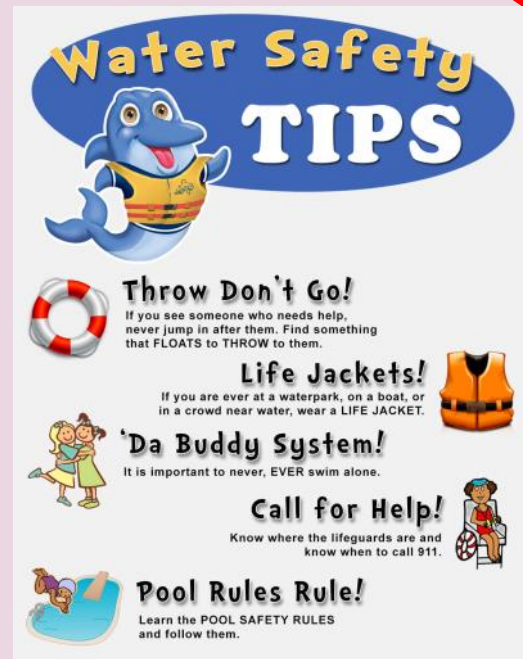
