team's first-ever medal in Para taekwondo. After escaping her home country of Afghanistan in 2021, Zakia showcased incredible resilience, dedicating her bronze medal to refugees worldwide. "I hope this medal will make a difference for refugees [...] and for all the women and girls with disabilities who find it difficult to take up sport," she said. 
School & Community Information
