Birdwatch is an annual UK-wide citizen science project held every January, inviting people to gather



data to support the work of scientists. Both the Big Garden and the Big Schools' Birdwatch offer people the chance to count birds visiting gardens, playgrounds or school outdoor spaces. This simple activity helps identify bird populations and the most common species. The data collected then helps scientists monitor bird numbers and deduce whether any species are in decline. Why don't you get involved at home? The children loved the idea.






School & Community Information
