Our PSHRE policy has been reviewed.

PSHRE lessons are taught using 3D PSHE scheme in Key Stage 1 and 2 and through Development Matters in the EYFS. This covers all of the statutory requirements of 'Relationships and Health Education (RHE)' and is a fundamental part of the curriculum. Schools must consult with stakeholders to ensure that there is a general consensus on our approaches to our policy.

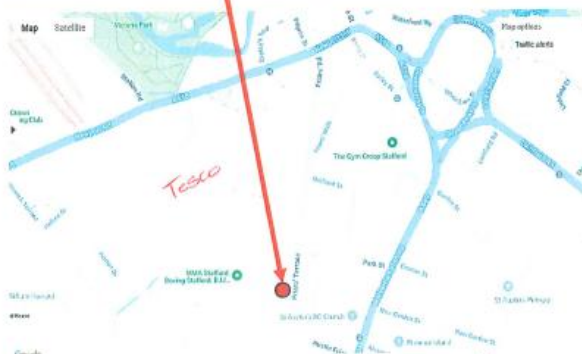
