

# **School & Community Information**

Due to rising food costs, Edwards and Ward have increased the price of school lunches to £3.20 from after Easter 2025. As always, we will continue to monitor the standards of lunches and ensure that our children receive the best quality possible. From 1st April 2025, our hourly charges for top up hours in our school nursery will be £5.43 per hour. This will only affect children who are entitled to 15 hours and choose to pay to remain at school for the full day. If you require support with payments / Parent Pay please speak to Mrs Stevens in the school office.





Our community hub is opening its doors on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday at 8.15am.

You can bring your child in for free cereal/toast and a drink. You will need to stay in the hub with them as it is not staffed by school it is being run by our volunteers. As the bell goes bring them into school.

The hub is there for anyone that this will help. Children that have had breakfast learn better! This is being run thanks to donations from The Spar on Cape Avenue, Asda and parent donations.

## **ECO NEWS**

In Eco Club this week, the children have been making fat balls for the wild birds.

If you want to make some yourself at home give it a go. It is fun and so easy to do.

Here is the recipe we used.

To make bird feeders with lard, follow these steps:

- 1. **Mix your dry ingredients**: Use a ratio of about 2 parts dry ingredients (such as oats, seeds, cooked rice, breadcrumbs and dried fruits) to 1 part lard or suet.
- 2. **Melt the lard or suet**: (You may be able to just soften it in your hands.
- 3. **Combine the melted fat with the dry ingredients**: Stir/squash until well mixed.
- 4. Shape the mixture into balls or moulds.
- 5. Hang the feeders outside for birds to enjoy


